 Calley. It was determined this option is not feasible for a variety of reasons. A Baltimore resident
 submitted a letter to the Baltimore Township Clerk to present at this meeting. She also had researched
 the grant option and came to the same conclusion that this would not be an option for Clear Lake.
- A Johnstown resident, Jill Rocco, meet with the Johnstown Township Clerk and Treasurer regarding her properties. She has three lots, 2 two back lots, and one front lot. Because of the unusual size and the road running through the property, she was asking if it would not be included.
- A Baltimore resident, Ron Felder, voiced his concern related to farming fertilizer practices and run-off into the lake. The resident further described a lack of inlets or outlets.
- A Johnstown resident, Monty Jones, remarked that present situation is most weeds ever observed in Clear Lake.
- A Johnstown resident, Jim Gray, asked what boundaries of the lake were in the proposed treatment zone, namely will sea wall to sea wall be treated as per his discussion with Andy at PLM.
