Winter Tax News

It is Winter Tax time again and I wanted to explain your Winter Tax Bill to you incase you have any questions on it. You will see the first few millages on your winter bill are for services available in Barry County such as Charlton Park, Commission on Aging, 911, Barry County Transit, and the Medical Care Facility. These are all voter passed mills. The next section is the Township Millages for Johnstown Township. These include Operating, a Fire Equipment a Fire Operating Millage and a Road Millage these millages help fund the fire department maintaining the roads and operation of all services here in Johnstown Township. Next you will have a millage for the Intermediate School District this is county wide and most of you will have Barry ISD but some will have Calhoun ISD or Kalamazoo ISD depending on the county you are in. Everyone in Michigan pays the Intermediate School District tax this is also voter passed mills. Following this will be your school districts millages. These are voted in millages and last for specific times and specific millage amounts these are also decided by your votes. Each school district has a different millage amount depending on what has been passed by voters. You will also see on your winter bill the Operating Millage for your school district, most residents will be exempt from this and it will only be levied if you do not have 100% Principle Resident Exemption. This millage is usually around 18 mills so if you qualify for PRE make sure you are receiving a exemption on this. Last are several different Assessments for various things. Drain assessments have been assessed by the Drain Commission and this year we have FineView Drain, Butler Lake Drain, and Clear Lake Drain. If you have questions on these Drain Assessments please call the Barry County Drain Commission at 269.945.1385. Other Assessments include weed control for Fine Lake and Mill Lake (Clear Lake should be on next years winter bills) and paving assessments for Walnut Ridge and Sleepy Hollow Drive.
