## **Tax Collection**

It is winter tax season again. You can pay your tax bill in person, mail, drop off at the drop box located in the front of the Township Hall, or pay online. If you choose to pay online visit our website at Johnstowntwp.org and following links to pay online. Collection hours at the Township Hall will be Mondays 9:00 am to 12:00 noon and Wednesdays 9:00 a.m. to 5:00p.m. Collection will begin December 4<sup>th</sup>. Please note: the office will be closed Monday Dec 25<sup>th</sup> and Monday Jan 1<sup>st</sup>. Last day to pay your winter taxes without penalty is February 14<sup>th</sup> 2024. The last day to pay the township your 2023 Summer and Winter taxes is February 28<sup>th</sup> 2024 with penalties due.

#### Transfer Station (Dump) 2994 Osborne Road (Corner of Osborne and Cobb Road)

Winter hours thru March Saturday 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Residents: No recycle fees; dump fees determined per vehicle and items for discard. Fees: Stop at entrance to present driver's license \$10/yard minim charge. Materials accepted: Cardboard, Plastic Metal – Scrap appliances, Metal, Tin Appliances: \$7/unit (non-freon) or \$25/unit containing Freon. Tires-Auto and light-duty trucks \$5/tire. Trucks \$15/tire, off-road \$50/tire Compost: 6.50/yard twigs and branches must be less than 2" in diameter and no longer than 6 ft.

#### SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS ON YOUR TAX BILL

Please Note: We have several special assessments that are on the tax bills this year. You may have a special assessment from the Drain Commission if you are on Clear Lake, Butler, or Fineview. New assessments with the township this year include Clear Lake and Bristol Lk Channel. Other ongoing assessments: Fine Lk, Mill Lk. Walnut Ridge and Sleepy Hollow.

### **ELECTION NEWS: Upcoming Presidential Primary and Early Voting**

<u>Presidential Primary</u>: At this time, it is expected the 2024 Michigan Presidential Primary will take place on Tuesday, February 27, 2024\* with polls open from 7:00 AM-8:00 PM.

**Early Voting:** Under authority granted in Public Act 81 of 2023, the Johnstown Township Board has established the Township Hall at 13641 S M 37 Hwy, Battle Creek, Michigan 49017, as an early voting site for all federal and statewide election dates.

All qualified electors in Johnstown Township that choose to participate in <u>early voting</u> have the right to mark a ballot and deposit the ballot in a tabulator from <u>8:30 AM to 4:30 PM</u> beginning the second Saturday before an election and ending the Sunday before the election, and any additional days prior to the second Saturday before an election that the Johnstown Township Board designates.
